Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Australia Membership Terms and Conditions

Definitions

HFSC: Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Australia

Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Steering Committee: A committee made up of Coalition partners, AFAC and FPA Australia, managing the strategy and governance of the HFSC

Commitment Period: The minimum term you are committing to remain a member of HFSC is up to twelve months from the date signed on the Membership form to December of the current year (fees calculated on a pro-rata basis). The membership may then be renewed on a calendar year basis from January to December.

Membership

By signing this Membership Application Form the member agrees to comply with these Terms and Conditions of Membership.

Annual membership fees / In-kind commitment

Annual membership fees and categories are listed on the Membership Application form. HFSC reserves the right to review and adjust fees from time to time. HFSC guarantees membership fees will not increase during your commitment period. Membership fees may be reduced by the HFSC with agreement for an in-kind commitment to the same or greater value than the fee reduction. This agreement must be in-place prior to signing the Membership Application Form.

HFSC (through the Fire Protection Association Australia) will invoice the member no more than 30 days after receiving the signed Membership Application Form. Failure to pay the invoice within 30 days will suspend the membership. Failure to carry out the agreed in-kind support by the member will result in a suspension of the membership.

Membership is based on an annual fee. This first year's fee will be calculated pro-rata till the end of the calendar year, then the full amount for following years.

Access to Discounts

If your membership category provides you with discounts to retailers or technical specifications, these will only be provided if your Commitment Period is greater than six months. When available, all discounts provided by third parties will be subject to their own terms and conditions.

Eligibility, Suspension or termination

We hope that you will be with the HFSC for a long time. But we may, using reasonable discretion, decide whether or not your personal and/or organisational conduct aligns with that of the HFSC. If it is deemed that your conduct and/or use of the membership with the HFSC does not align with our Code of Conduct and/or your actions could cause harm to us or other members, the HFSC reserves the right to suspend or terminate the membership.

You also have the right to suspend or terminate your membership with the HFSC at any time, however, except for rights afforded to you under Australian law, the HFSC will not refund any remaining fees or donations.

Membership Code of Conduct

As a member of the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition I will:

- Contribute proactively to improving home fire safety through supporting the increased installation of reliable and cost-effective residential fire sprinklers
- Demonstrate a commitment to best-practice and continual improvement of the industry
- Conduct my business in accordance with the laws and regulations in the jurisdiction that I operate
- Compete fairly in the markets that I operate
- Work safely and apply industry best practice to the health and safety of employees, clients and the community
- Co-operate with and support the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Australia to achieve its objectives
- Not make representations to the media, government or public on behalf of the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Australia
- Use the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Australia promotional material for its intended use and seek approval from the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Steering Committee for use of its branding and identification
- Act ethically and with integrity
- Not be involved in corrupt practices, bribery, discrimination or similar practices

I accept that if the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition Steering Committee reviews and determines that I have breached any principle of the Code of Conduct my membership may be suspended or terminated.
